PART A:

The plan of action chalked out by the IQAC for academic excellence and the outcome achieved by the end of the year.

For achieving academic excellence in higher education more as a mission than a mere academic exercise, St. Xavier's College in the academic year 2009 – 2010 set before itself the tasks of sustaining the levels in academics achieved over the years and also adopting ways by which the institution could grow to provide new initiatives for the benefit of our students so as to make possible an educational experience that would be wholesome, productive and progressive.

This responsibility was shared by all the stakeholders right from the management to the teaching and administrative staff, students, parents and the community we aim to serve. Blending values into the pursuit of academic excellence has remained our special focus in the curricular and co-curricular activities this year. Learning experiences outside the class-room have been provided through various activities on campus and beyond like extension and community services via the NSS (National Social Service), NCC (National Cadet Corps), AICUF (All India Catholic University Federation) Child Labour Cell ` etc.

As the academic year 2009-2010 draws to a close we can look back with satisfaction at a year that was eventful and fruitful in achieving our objectives to sustain quality and enhance our performance which Part B of this report will highlight.

PART B:

1. ACTIVITIES REFLECTING THE GOALS OF THE COLLEGE

***Our Vision:** Formation for Transformation.*

***Our Mission:** To provide balanced all round education to young men and women, to be disciplined citizens, who will display a high intellectual calibre together with emotional balance and social commitment and particularly, at helping catholic youth to be committed followers of Christ.*

To realize the VISION and MISSION of St. Xavier's College, the students were encouraged into several activities to support and supplement their class-room learning.

(A) ADMISSION POLICY:

In admitting students into the various courses/programs offered by the Institution, we are guided by the founding goals and the ethos in general. The process of admitting students to the various courses is done through a transparent mechanism, complying with the norms of the DHE (Directorate of Higher Education) and Goa University.

For all courses applicants are short-listed through a process of selection based on merit, pre-admission interaction with the counseling committee and interview with the Principal. Special efforts are made to admit students from socio-economically backward communities, financially weaker families, differently abled, sports persons and others. The college has provision for providing freeships/scholarships/schemes for financially weaker students.

Admission tests and interviews are conducted for specialization courses, namely Mass Communication and Videography, Journalism, Bachelor in Computer Applications (BCA), Bachelor in Business Administration (BBA), Bachelor in Tourism and Travel Management (BTTM).

An Orientation Programme for the First Year students of the Under-graduate level is held at the beginning of the academic year. The programme includes:

- General information on various campus facilities available
- Stream-wise subject orientation covering courses, content and job opportunities.

- Information on the college library and optimum use of its facilities.
- Sports facilities and opportunities.
- Orientation of co-curricular activities specially NCC and NSS programmes.
- Information on college associations, clubs, cells and the nature of their activities for the development of the students.
- For the Third Year students, an orientation on the Project Paper, guidelines on choosing project topics, assessment and marking scheme

(B) LEARNING AND CAPACITY-BUILDING STRATEGIES:

NSS (National Service Scheme)

The NSS unit of St. Xavier's has exposed our students to the issues and problems of the society. To create social consciousness and to encourage respect and dignity for labour through participation in social service. While the general motto of the NSS remains 'Not me but you', the NSS unit of St. Xavier's adopted as its theme for the year 2009-2010, '*Empowering Youth for Social Transformation*'. Various activities were organized on campus and outside as a part of our social outreach and extension programmes. These activities will be highlighted in the report.

NCC (National Cadet Corps)

The NCC unit of St. Xavier's College has contributed in a significant way to the all round development of its members over the years. The College has a girls unit and a boys unit. Their activities include those that help in building personality character and qualities of co-operation and competition. Our cadets have been recognized for their excellence at the State Zonal and National Level.

Cadet Verlin Dias was selected for the Republic Day 2010; she was also selected to go to Singapore, to represent India for the Youth Exchange Programme (YEP).

JCUO Eeshan Usapkar won the Best Cadet Award in a competition organized by Ex-NCC Cadets Association at Campal, Panaji. He also won two gold medals for Debate and Master of Ceremony, one bronze for Group Cultural Performance and one special trophy for overall participation.

The 'Best Cadet Prize 2009-10' was shared by cadets, SCUO Eeshan Uspakar, SCUO Leroy Coelho and JCUO Rashmi Shettigar

(C) HEALTHY PRACTICES:

Encouraging students into practices that will reinforce discipline and values imbibed in the classroom, St. Xavier's has adopted certain practices that would make their learning experience more complete and would help build good character. These, we call, as Healthy Practices. To mention a few, the morning prayers, a Teacher–Mentor programme, value – education classes, commemoration of International Days, Mental Health Week, World Breast Feeding Week, Hindi Day, Educational Apostolate Day, World Tourism Day etc., these are intended to provide opportunities for self-development, discipline, sensitivity to issues, local, national and international.

(D) VALUE EDUCATION:

Accepting the principle that 'values cannot be taught, but they have to be caught...' St. Xavier's has a code of conduct which is stated in the college Handbook, besides, every student is expected to be disciplined on campus. To further strengthen their character formation, the College conducts weekly Value-education sessions. These sessions are animated by the faculty of the College as well as guest lecturers. The sessions include talks, audio-visual presentations, educational documentaries and discussions on topics like: human values and development, religion and morality, generation gap, leadership, sex education, interpersonal relations, gender issues, personal growth, urbanization and environmental problems, genetic engineering – respect for life and creation, street children and prostitution etc.

(E) CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES:

Co-curricular activities are intended to enhance the many talents that students have and to supplement and strengthen their classroom learning. These are activities carried out through Cells, Associations, Clubs, Linkages, Seminars, Workshops and Film Festivals. At St. Xavier's we have twenty-five Cells/Clubs/Associations that organize activities that help students to engage in capacity building activities. Students are encouraged to join at least two such associations so that they can discover and develop their talents and interests.

The College participated in several inter-collegiate events with the twin purpose of exposure to the competitive world and to build in them enduring qualities that will

help them cope with challenges beyond College. These events will feature in the report later. Summer courses were also organized in April both for the students and the general public.

4. EXAMINATION REFORMS IMPLEMENTED

Under the newly implemented six- semester system at the under-graduate level, a new scheme of examination was introduced since 2007-2008 with two broad modes of academic

assessment of the students for the six semesters, namely the Intra-Semester Assessment (ISA) and the Semester End Examination (SEE).

EXAMINATION PATTERN FOR F.Y. / S.Y. / T.Y.BA/BCOM/BSC

INTRA-SEMESTER ASSESSMENT (ISA)

In each semester a student is evaluated using two different modes of testing. For example a written test, oral test, assignment, or seminar mode. A student has to compulsorily answer two ISAs to qualify for the Semester end examination. The ISA carries 20% of maximum marks allotted for the paper.

SEMESTER END EXAMINATION

The SEE is conducted for the balance 80% marks allotted for the paper. A student has to secure a minimum of 40% of the maximum marks in the ISA and SEE components taken together to pass in each paper for each semester. Repeat SEEs are conducted to enable students to clear their backlog of papers of previous semesters. no student is admitted into semester V who has not cleared all his papers of I- IV.

For the smooth conduct of the SEE, a Committee is appointed by the Principal for each year, and for each stream. This committee also functions as the Promotion Committee.

EXAMINATION PATTERN FOR F.Y. / S.Y. / T.Y.BBA/BTTM/BCA

Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA), Bachelor of Travel and Tourism Management (BTTM) and Bachelor of Computer Application (BCA) follow the semester pattern and continuous evaluation system.

Similarly the Post Graduate Courses i.e. MA, M.Com and M.Sc followed the examination pattern as prescribed in the Ordinance.

38) HEALTHY PRACTICES OF THE INSTITUTION

The following healthy practices are adopted at St. Xavier’s College to inculcate virtue, discipline along with academics

On the given performa, they identify the nearest value applicable to their teacher express their opinions and suggestions. These sheets are then given to the respective teachers. The assessment helps the teacher to get a feed back on her/ his teaching and take corrective measures if required.
- **Departmental Meetings:** Every Department holds its Departmental meetings with its faculty members to discuss the agenda for the semester and other matters of academic concern.
- **Modern Teaching Aids:** Teachers are encouraged to use modern teaching aids like overhead projector and LCD projector.
- **Personal Identity :** Students have to wear a Identity Card with lanyard around the neck. The color of the lanyard identifies the students to their respective streams.
- **Value Education:** Once a week value education is offered to all students. These lectures highlight topics on waste management and garbage disposal and values in general. Resource persons are invited to deliver lectures on such topics besides the college faculty
